


#### **BACKGROUND AND HISTORY**

In the late 1980s, Sgt. Dave Scheppegrell started the first boys club at Marie G. Davis Elementary. Simultaneously, Frank Bragg was board chair and a founder of Kids' Repay, a juvenile restitution program. RMFY was incorporated as a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization on March 12, 1993 by these community pillars, with a mission of providing resources and guidance to help students graduate high school with a plan for their future success. The idea of Right Moves for Youth quickly spread to dozens of schools. The heart of the program is the strong partnership that RMFY has with the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Schools (CMS), Charlotte-Mecklenburg Police Department, United Way, Mecklenburg County Sheriff's Office, and the community at large.

Since inception, RMFY has served over 35,000 students, providing quality services to youth in the Charlotte-Mecklenburg community. The core of our programming is weekly group facilitation based on a group counseling model. With this model, we provide empowerment and support to young people in areas of life skills development, college/career readiness, service/civic engagement, leadership development, social-emotional support, and school accountability. RMFY has successfully helped to reduce school dropout, suspension, and chronic absenteeism.

To generate excitement and resources for RMFY's program, the Twilight 5K was started in May 1996, with the help of former RMFY board member Roger Cobb and Paisley Cobb. With over 1,500 registrants, the Twilight 5K is one of Charlotte's largest evening races. Over the lifetime of the 5K, more than \$1,000,000 has been raised with the goal of providing resources and opportunities to our youth who face many challenges. This event has helped RMFY provide students with various service projects, field trips, college tours, leadership programs, cultural immersion opportunities, and much more.



#### THE ROLE OF SPONSORS
