Our Small Group Mentoring program provides weekly school-based and virtual group mentoring services modeled after adolescent group counseling. It focuses on the following pillars: education, social-emotional well-being, college and career readiness, and civic duty and personal leadership.

Right Moves For Youth is in 20 schools, serving 907 students in Charlotte-Mecklenburg in the 2024-2025 school year. Impact includes a 100% graduation and promotion rate, with just about 70% of RMFY students stating that they planned to attend college or a technical school post-graduation and are taking career-focused classes to prepare.
